Fiscal Impact Summary

This bill requires the General Assembly to appropriate the necessary funds for two full-time employees in each county veterans' affairs office. Currently, Proviso 113.1 of the FY 2023-24 Appropriations Act specifies that each county receives an effective annual amount equal to one hundred percent of the amount allocated to it for the prior fiscal year plus an amount equivalent to base pay increases for state employees, less any adjustments made for budget reductions. According to the Department of Veterans' Affairs (DVA) the total General Fund appropriation pursuant to this proviso in FY 2023-24 is \$303,576. Dividing this total by 2 employees for each of the 46 counties, or a total of 92 employees, this results in an average of \$3,300 per employee currently. Depending upon the amount of salary and fringe the General Assembly allocates per employee, this bill will result in an undetermined increase of General Fund revenue appropriated to the county veterans' affairs offices beginning in FY 2024-25.

Explanation of Fiscal Impact

State Revenue
