Fiscal Impact Summary

This bill, as amended, requires the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) to establish a work zone safety program to educate the motoring public on the dangers of committing moving violations while traveling in highway construction work zones. The agency must require all persons obtaining an initial driver's license who are required to complete a driver's education course to also take the work zone safety program course. DMV anticipates that the bill will have no expenditure impact on the agency because the cost to develop the training and the website can be managed within existing appropriations.
