### **Fiscal Impact Summary**

This bill modifies the pro-rated determination for the payments made from the Grain and Cotton Producers Guaranty Fund when there are insufficient funds to cover all claims. This bill also adds cotton producers to the producers who may receive an exemption from participating in the fund.

The South Carolina Department of Agriculture (SCDA) anticipates being able to manage any additional expenses due to this bill with existing staff and within existing appropriations.

Also, as the modification of the pro-rata distribution does not change the total amount that may distributed from the fund, this bill will have no Other Funds revenue impact.

# **Explanation of Fiscal Impact**

## **Introduced on March 7, 2023 State Expenditure**

This bill modifies the pro-rated determination for the payments made from the Grain and Cotton Producers Guaranty Fund when there are insufficient funds to cover all claims. Currently, the pro-rata determination is based on 100 percent of the total loss of each producer. This bill specifies that the pro-rata determination will be based on the total loss and the total number of exemptions granted to the producer. The more exemptions granted, the lower the share the producer will receive. Currently, the pro-rata distribution is based on the total loss of each producer. This bill also adds cotton producers to the producers who may receive an exemption from participating in the fund.

SCDA is currently issuing exemptions for cotton producers, upon request. Additionally, SCDA is collecting and maintaining data necessary to implement the pro-rata distribution if necessary. Therefore, SCDA anticipates being able to manage any additional expenses due to this bill with existing staff and within existing appropriations.

#### **State Revenue**

This bill modifies the pro-rated determination for the payments made from the Grain and Cotton Producers Guaranty Fund when there are insufficient funds to cover all claims. This bill also adds cotton producers to the producers who may receive an exemption from participating in the fund.

As the modification of the pro-rata distribution does not change the total amount that may distributed from the fund and SCDA is currently issuing exemptions to cotton producers, this bill will have no Other Funds revenue impact.
