Fiscal Impact Summary

This bill amends the definition of firefighter, as it relates to the Firefighter Cancer Health Care Benefit Plan, by deleting the requirement that the person must be a resident of this state when engaging in rescue, fire suppression, or related activities in this state. The Office of the State Fire Marshal, which is under the administration of the Department of Labor, Licensing and Regulation (LLR), administers the plan, for which the current General Fund appropriation is \$3,500,000. The fiscal impact of the bill on LLR and the General Fund is pending, contingent upon further information.
