## **Fiscal Impact Summary**

This bill requires the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) to establish a work zone safety program to educate the motoring public on the dangers of committing moving violations while traveling in highway construction work zones. DMV must require all persons obtaining an initial driver's license to take the work zone safety program course. The agency anticipates that the bill will have no expenditure impact because the cost to develop the training and the website can be managed within existing appropriations.
