This joint resolution proposes a constitutional amendment that must appear on ballot of the next general election. The proposed amendment is to clarify that only a citizen of the United States and this State who is at least eighteen years of age and properly registered is entitled to vote.

Based on responses to similar joint resolutions, the Revenue and Fiscal Affairs Office (RFA) anticipates this joint resolution will have no expenditure impact for the State Election Commission. The agency will be able to manage adding this proposed amendment to the ballot for the next general election within the normal course of business.
