## **Fiscal Impact Summary**

This bill removes education attainment provisions from the requirements for restricted instructors' licenses issued by the Board of Dentistry enumerated in Section 40-15-175(A).

The Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation (LLR) does not anticipate the bill will alter the primary responsibilities of the agency or the Board of Dentistry. LLR further anticipates that the expenditure impact to implement the provisions of the bill will be minimal and can be managed within existing appropriations.
