Fiscal Impact Summary

This bill adds “billboard structure” to the installation, repair, or maintenance of signs and billboards in a list of situations that are exempted from requiring contractor licensure. This bill does not alter the requirement that an electrical license is required to install, modify, or perform a final connection to a branch circuit conductor.

Contractor licensure is regulated by the Contractor’s Licensing Board, which is under the administration of the Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation (LLR). LLR anticipates that the bill will have no expenditure impact on the agency as it does not alter the responsibilities of the agency or the Contractor’s Licensing Board.

State Expenditure
