Fiscal Impact Summary

This bill specifies that the Northeastern Technical College Area Commission representation from local industry may have one ex-officio member appointed by a majority of the Northeastern Technical College Area legislative delegation consisting of one appointment per county. The bill further states that the industry leaders from Chesterfield, Dillon, and Marlboro counties are ex-officio members of the commission and serve at the will of the legislative delegation.

This bill will have no expenditure impact. The Technical College System (Tech System) indicates that the bill’s addition of ex-officio members to the Northeastern Technical College Area Commission, and any resulting expenses including per diem, mileage, and subsistence will be minimal and managed with existing resources by Northeastern Technical College.

Explanation of Fiscal Impact

State Expenditure

This bill specifies that the Northeastern Technical College Area Commission representation from local industry may have one ex-officio member appointed by a majority of the Northeastern Technical College Area legislative delegation consisting of one appointment per county.
