Fiscal Impact Summary

This bill specifies that a certified registered nurse anesthetist may only use the abbreviation “CRNA” or a variation or sub-designation of CRNA to indicate that the person is practicing as a certified registered nurse anesthetist.

This bill does not alter the responsibilities of the Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation (LLR) or the Board of Nursing. Therefore, LLR anticipates that this bill will have no fiscal impact on the department or respective board.
